TO ALL TO WHOM these Presents shall come, GREETING: KNOW YE, that

the Composition of One pound Sterling paid by Francis Green into the late Receiver Generals Office

there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto *the said Francis Green*

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing *Two hundred & twenty three acres by Survey bearing date the*

*11th of September One thousand Seven hundred & thirty one lying and being in the County of Rockingham
Virginia on a Branch of Lincolns brook, and bounded as followeth, To wit, Beginning at a black Oak his corner
thence North five degrees West Sixteen poles to a white and black oak Saplings his corner, West forty poles to
two black oak Saplings; South sixty poles to a black oak; thence South Seventy degrees East One hundred
poles to a Chesnut Oak; North Eighty five degrees East forty poles to a black oak Sapling; South
degrees East Eighty four poles to two black Oaks; North thirty degrees East eight poles to two
Pines corner; North twenty degrees East One hundred and twenty poles to a white oak his corner; South
twenty degrees East forty poles to a black oak; thence North forty degrees West forty poles to a white oak
thence South sixty eight degrees West two hundred and ten poles to the Beginning*

with its Appurtenances; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land with its Appurtenances, to
the said *Francis Green* and his Heirs for ever.

IN WITNESS whereof, the said *Edmund Randolph Esq* Governor of the

Commonwealth of VIRGINIA, hath hereunto set his Hand, and caused the lesser Seal of the said Commonwealth to be
affixed at Richmond, on the *nineteenth* Day of *December* in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand

Seven Hundred and Eighty-*Six* and of the Commonwealth the *Eleventh*
