The **January 7, 2020** meeting of the Rockingham County Electoral Board was called to order at 9:07 a.m. in the Rockingham County Voter Registrar's office by Linda Shuler, Chair. Electoral Board members attending: Linda Shuler, Chair; Trish Philon, Vice Chair; and Susan Threewitts, Secretary. Also in attendance was Director of Elections, Lisa B. Gooden.

Purpose of the Meeting: The purpose of the meeting was to conduct the Logic & Accuracy (L & A) testing for the March 3, 2020 Democratic Party Presidential Primary.

Approval of Minutes of November 6, 2019 Canvass of Votes: A motion was made by Trish Philon, seconded by Susan Threewitts, and unanimously carried, to approve the minutes, as presented.

Relocation of Precinct 103-Fulks Run (Voter Notification Letters): Lisa Gooden apprised members that letters were mailed January 2, 2020 advising voters who are registered in precinct 103-Fulks Run that their polling location will be moved from the Chimney Rock VFW Post 9660 back to its original location at Fulks Run Elementary School, effective immediately, and due to the completion of school construction at the elementary school.

March 3, 2020 Democratic Party Presidential Primary: Lisa Gooden mentioned that a list of election officers who will be available to serve for this primary is being compiled and will be completed in the weeks ahead. Election officer training dates have been scheduled for 6 PM on Wednesday, February 19, and Thursday, February 20, at 10 AM, both in the Board Room.

Election Officer Appointments: Members agreed to consider the appointment of election officers to a three-year term at a meeting on February 4, beginning at 9:30 AM.



After brief discussion, members suggested that this matter be placed on the agenda for the February 4 meeting.
