The enclosed Voter Information Notice provides you with information on **WHERE** you need to go to vote. You do **NOT** need to take this notice with you when voting. Currently, a **valid Photo ID** is the only item you need to present when voting.

Absentee Voting (In Person and by Mail) Begins 45 days prior to EVERY election (Refer to dates above). If you know you will **not** be able to vote in person at your polling location, consider voting IN PERSON at our office; or, vote absentee (by mail) may be filed online, submitted to the Voter Registrar's Office by mail (address listed above), via email (lgooden@rockinghamcountyva.gov), by FAX (540-564-3057), or online: <http://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal/index.html>. A full list of qualifying reasons for voting absentee are noted on the back of this page. **Absentee ballots may be requested in advance of the election or primary.**



Curbside Voting is offered for **ALL elections** and at **ALL voting precincts** on **Election Day (6 AM – 7 PM)**. If you or a family member has an illness or disability, you may be assisted at your vehicle. Also, you may wish to consider absentee voting (by mail).
