I. CALL TO ORDER

III. NEW BUSINESS – Park Considerations & Updates

- a. Staff will seek out new sponsorship opportunities since the pandemic cut short our process last year.
- b. Park is booked for rentals for the spring through fall 2021. Lots of activities from baseball/softball tournaments to soccer and football practices. Mr. Knorr and his staff are currently working on an outdoor classroom area.
- c. Mr. Dean requested that an executive committee be formed for the Park Foundation. The committee would consist of two people who are current members of the Park Foundation and the Recreation Commission. The Executive Committee would be able to meet for more frequently if needed after the Recreation Commission meetings which are held six times per year. Any financial decisions concerning money from the foundation will still require the approval of all Park Foundation Board members.
- d. On a motion from Mr. Chandler and seconded by Mr. King the members voted and approved that an Executive Committee be formed with a chairman and vice chairman.
- e. On a motion from Mr. Fulk, he nominated Mr. Wayland as Chairman and was seconded by Mr. King. Mr. Chandler nominated Mr. Fulk as Vice Chairman and was seconded by Mr. Wayland. The members voted and approved Glen Wayland, Chairman and Donnie Fulk, Vice Chairman of the Executive Committee.
- f. Members discussed ideas for new projects and events that could be held at the park. Mr. Miller suggested an amphitheater that would include purchasing additional, adjacent property to help with parking. Mr. Wayland asked to have a feasibility study done for this project.
- g. It was suggested at looking to VDOT for road work on Indian Trail to make a safer entrance and exit at the park.
- h. Mr. Dean discussed ideas for a field house at the park with gym space, classrooms, etc.
