



The **February 25, 2021** meeting of the Rockingham County Electoral Board was called to order at 10:08 a.m. in the Fire & Rescue training room, 20 East Gay Street (Entrance A), in Harrisonburg, VA. The purpose of this meeting was to participate in the statewide Risk Limiting Audit for the November 3, 2020 General Election, including only the offices of President and U.S. Senate.

Electoral Board members attending the meeting included: Mike Auchard, Chair; Sandra L. Parks, Vice Chair; and Susan C. Threewitts, Secretary. Also in attendance: Lisa B. Gooden, Director of Elections; Zachery Weaver, Deputy Director of Elections; and Chaz Haywood, Circuit Court Clerk.

Observers in attendance included: William Anthony (Republican Party) and Jeff Roadcap. Also attending: Mark Finks, Director of Elections for the City of Harrisonburg.

Risk Limiting Audit: Circuit Court Clerk Haywood released the specified ballots to the Electoral Board who conducted the risk limiting audit.

The Audit Board was made up of Mike Auchard (D) and Susan C. Threewitts (R). Sandra Parks served as the random number generator. Members used a K-cut method which resulted in each member of the Audit Board dividing the stack of ballots three times. The ballot that was on top ended up being the ballot that was recorded.


