



The **September 15, 2021** meeting of the Rockingham County Electoral Board was called to order at 9:38 a.m. in the Registrar's Office annex (former CSA office), 20 East Gay Street, Harrisonburg, by Board Chair Robert (Mike) Auchard. Electoral Board members attending the meeting: Mike Auchard, Chair; Sandra Parks, Vice Chair; and Susan Threewitts, Secretary. Also attending the meeting: Lisa B. Gooden, Director of Elections; Zachery Weaver, Deputy Registrar; Kimberly Shoup-Erney and Mason Brown (Election Services Online-ESO). Also in attendance: Jeff Roadcap and Daryl Borgquist, observers.

Approval of Minutes of June 8, 2021: A motion was made by Sandra Parks, seconded by Susan Threewitts, and unanimously carried, to accept the minutes of April 12, 2021, as presented.

Relocation of Precinct 403-Mt. Crawford: Lisa Gooden informed the Board that the relocation of 403-Mt Crawford from the Ruritan Hall to the Mt. Crawford Town Municipal building has been finalized with approval being granted by the Office of the Attorney General. She said voter notification letters have also been mailed.

Registrant Count: Lisa Gooden provided members with the most up to date registrant count for Rockingham County noting that there are 55,038 voters.

Ballot Order for November 2, 2021 General and Special Elections: A motion was made by Susan Threewitts, seconded by Sandra Parks, to set the ballot order for the November 2, 2021 General and Special Elections at 100%

VEBA Western Region: Mike Auchard and Susan Threewitts gave a report on this meeting held recently in Augusta County and reviewed some of the changes that


will be in effect with this election, including, banning conceal carry in polling places, drop box monitoring, and insurance for officers of election.
