



The Canvass of Votes by the Rockingham County Electoral Board was called to order at 9:30 AM on **Wednesday, November 8, 2023**, in the Registrar's Office annex by Chair Sandra Parks. Members attending included: Sandra Parks, Chair; Rebecca Ruckman, Vice Chair; and Susan Threewitts, Secretary. Also in attendance: Lisa B. Gooden, Director of Elections; Nicholas Ocampo, Chief Deputy Director of Elections; and Daryl Borgquist, Rockingham County Republican Party Chair.

Approval of Minutes of September 27, 2023: A motion was made by Susan Threewitts, seconded by Sandra Parks, and unanimously carried, to approve the minutes of the special meeting of September 27, 2023, as presented.

Election Day Issues with Electronic Pollbooks: Nick Ocampo apprised the Board that there were multiple precinct chiefs who experienced problems with their electronic pollbooks on Election Day. He said several of the precinct chiefs began using paper pollbooks at the start of the day due to problems with the Merlin not connecting/communicating with the laptops. He mentioned that DemTech, the pollbook vendor, was contacted but there was little assistance offered. He reminded members that last year, there were issues in two precincts, but the problems during the recent election were quite different and more widespread from the previous year. He mentioned that there were no pollbook issues during the 45-day early voting timeframe.

Other concerns mentioned by members of the Board included campaigners at a few of the precincts. It was mentioned that some took up parking spots for extended periods of the day, resulting in limited parking for voters. Clear access to polling place entrances was another concern, as well as overzealous campaigners' behavior bordering 'voter intimidation.'

There was brief discussion on ways that election officers could be supported in future elections and that some official information may need to be distributed to campaigners that outline rules, including, not blocking/impeding roadways or entrances/exits, and not aggressively approaching voters, to name a few.

Polling Place Accessibility Checklist Required by ELECT: An update regarding the recent ADA checklist was presented to members. It was noted that this will continue to be reviewed and updated. It was mentioned that the county's maintenance department along with the county school's maintenance department, have worked extensively to address concerns. As far as future issues/signage at the schools, this will need to be handled by county maintenance.


