At a Court held for the County of Rockingham on Tuesday the 21st day of June 1842 John Cowan who was appointed a Commissioner at the June Court 1841 To lay off the public Roads in this County into fit and convenient precincts Number each Precinct Beginning at N^o One and to give each road a proper Name and to assign to each Precinct some proper Person to act as Surveyor thereof and to allot the Tithables to work on each precinct, made a report which was examined and approved by the Court and ordered to be Recorded in a Book to be kept for that Purpose and it is further ordered that the several persons as surveyors named be appointed surveyors of said precincts who with the Tithables allotted thereto are hereby directed to open the said Roads work thereon and keep the same in good repair as the law directs


