The **April 26, 2017** meeting of the Rockingham County Electoral Board was called to order by Linda Shuler, Chair, at 8:45 a.m. in the Voter Registrar's Office. Electoral Board members attending the meeting were: Linda Shuler, Trish Philon, and Susan Threewitts. Also attending was Rockingham County Voter Registrar/Director of Elections, Lisa B. Gooden.

The minutes from the March 6, 2017 meeting were presented and approved, upon a motion by Trish Philon, seconded by Susan Threewitts, and unanimously carried.

Voter Registrar Lisa Gooden noted that on April 12, Rockingham County and Harrisonburg Voter Registrars hosted the Regional Voter Registrars Association of Virginia (VRAV) meeting in the Community Development meeting room. Attendance included 15 of the 16 localities in Region 6, and Jennifer Frederick, Deputy Registrar and Lisa Gooden presented a program on Rockingham County's initiative to digitize records, including the scanning of Alpha cards. Lisa noted that the program was enjoyed by the group as only one other locality (Waynesboro) currently practices this method of electronic recordkeeping.

Regarding training for the upcoming June 13 dual primary, Lisa reminded the Board that training of Election Officers will be held on Tuesday May 16, beginning at 5 p.m. in the Community Room and Board of Supervisors Room. The Electoral Board is asked to arrive by 5 p.m. to allow chiefs the opportunity to count their ballots and sign necessary paperwork prior to the training. The Registrar's office will be open that day 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. to allow for absentee voting prior to the training and also following the training.

Lisa apprised members that, on May 31 from 1:30 p.m.-3:30 p.m., she will participate in the health fair at Sunnyside Retirement Communities, offering information about the upcoming election, voter registration and photo IDs.

The Electoral Board recessed at 9 a.m. for the Logic & Accuracy testing with Election Services Online in preparation for the June 13 primary, upon a motion by Trish Philon, seconded by Susan Threewitts, and unanimously carried.

Following testing, the Board adjourned their meeting at 2 p.m., upon a motion by Susan Threewitts, seconded by Trish Philon, and unanimously carried.
