

Rockingham Broadband Update

December 10, 2025

Broadband Project Overall Status

- Dominion middle mile construction is 80% complete
 - 107 of 133 miles built; splicing to APB fiber on rolling basis
 - Connectivity to APB Augusta network
- VDOT land use permit status
 - Strong, collaborative relationship with Harrisonburg residency; volume of permit applications, oversight, and inspection are significant
 - APB maintaining sufficient bond capacity statewide
- SVEC pole attachment application have begun to be submitted
 - Significant milestone achieved to reach submittal stage
 - Make-ready construction progress will be reported beginning in January
- Expect communications from APB to being 60-90 days in advance of serviceability
 - Customer activations expected to begin in early 2026 and will continue on a rolling basis


