VDOT Entrance Permit

Sections 33.2-240 & 33.2-241 of the Code of Virginia govern the ability of private homes, commercial businesses, and agricultural activities to connect their private roads over and across the shoulders and unimproved parts of the State highway system to the paved or otherwise improved parts thereof. New entrances are obtained through a permitting process administered by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) that is intended to ensure that entrances are safe and appropriate.

This process is required for all construction entrances shown on the approved erosion and sediment control plan. Contact VDOT's local Harrisonburg Residency at (540) 434-2586.

Any operation that is to take place in a FEMA designated floodplain must be in compliance with the Rockingham County Floodplain Ordinance which states that "with the special floodplain area no new construction or development shall be allowed unless it is demonstrated that the cumulative effect of the proposed development, when combined with other existing and anticipated development, will not increase the elevation of the one hundred (100) year flood more than one (1) foot at any point." In order to perform any operation, regardless of total disturbed square footage, in a FEMA designated floodplain you must submit an engineer's designed plan proving that the base flood elevation will not increase more than one (1) foot. Along with this plan you will need to file the appropriate paperwork with FEMA for conducting work within a designated floodplain.
